### Bruce Thompson

Bruce Thompson is the Program Director for Moreland Energy Foundation Ltd. Bruce has taken an active leadership role developing the Phoenix Fridge Project in partnership with the Brotherhood of St Laurence and EcoSmart Electricians (a national training and accreditation scheme in partnership with the National Electrical Contractors Association (NECA)). Bruce has a technical background in energy management and extensive experience in community partnership development, working for many years in advocacy roles for a national environment NGO. He is a qualified Engineer, has a post graduate certificate in Project Management and is presently completing a Masters in Engineering (Sustainable Energy). Bruce was awarded the Brian Robinson Fellowship in 2007 for Environmental Leadership and undertook a study tour of the Europe to investigate decentralised energy. The study tour is presently informing his role as project manager of the recently announced Moreland Solar City.

## Who Should Attend?

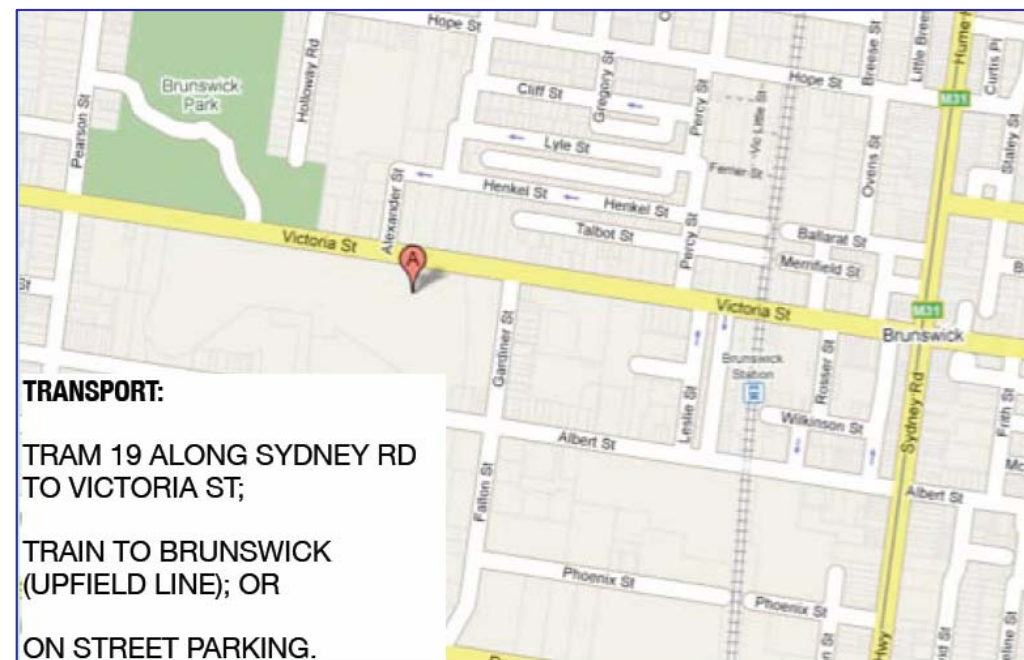
